



COVID–19 updates: (As of December 16th, 2020)

Scout Activities and Meetings

With our service area now in the moderate transmission range we want to emphasize precautions to take during Scouting activities.

Units should continue to seek the guidance and follow the procedures as established by their chartered partners and understand the comfort level of their youth and parents in participating in in-person meetings. We encourage Units to use both the unit restart checklist and for outings the COVID-19 prescreening checklist.

Pima County Health Department as of December 2020 Local COVID-19 Prevention Recommendations.

The Health Department is recommending the public follow these guidelines and protective measures.

Individuals/Small Groups:

- **All medically vulnerable people and people over age 65 should continue to stay home as much as possible**
- **All physical distancing measures should remain in place (stay six feet apart, avoid shaking hands)**
- **No groups of greater than 10 should hold meetings indoors.**
- **Open windows and doors to allow airflow, weather permitting, if gathering indoors**
- **No groups greater than 25 should gather outside**
- **Wear masks and stay six feet apart from others even if meeting outdoors.**
- **Participants are to bring own food, drinks, and treats. Do not share utensils or drinking cups.**
- **Keep a list of individuals involved to help with contact tracing, if needed.**

*** For all phases of the recovery, the public should continue good prevention practices:**

- **Stay home if sick**
- **Wash hands with soap and water/hand sanitizer**
- **Avoid touching face**
- **Sneeze/cough into a tissue or elbow.**
- **Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces**
- **Use cloth face coverings while in public**
- **Continue physical distancing and use protective equipment**
- **Temperature/wellness checks at entrances to public buildings and workplaces**
- **Sanitization and disinfection of common and high-traffic areas**
- **Limitations on business travel**

Will remain open for unit use, following the above guidelines. Limited cabin rentals during the week for families of ten or less are available.

Council Service Center & Scout Shop

The Council Service Center in Tucson will continue to operate with limited public access.

The Catalina Scout Shop will continue with reduced hours and some restrictions. New hours will be Tuesday-Friday 10 AM to 5 PM and Saturday 9 AM to 1 PM. The Shop will be closed on Sundays and Mondays. There will be a limit of 3 customers in the store at a time and no cash, checks, or returns. Restrooms and dressing room will be closed. We will be following CDC guidelines for cleaning and social distancing. Curbside deliveries and mail orders will be in place for your convenience.
