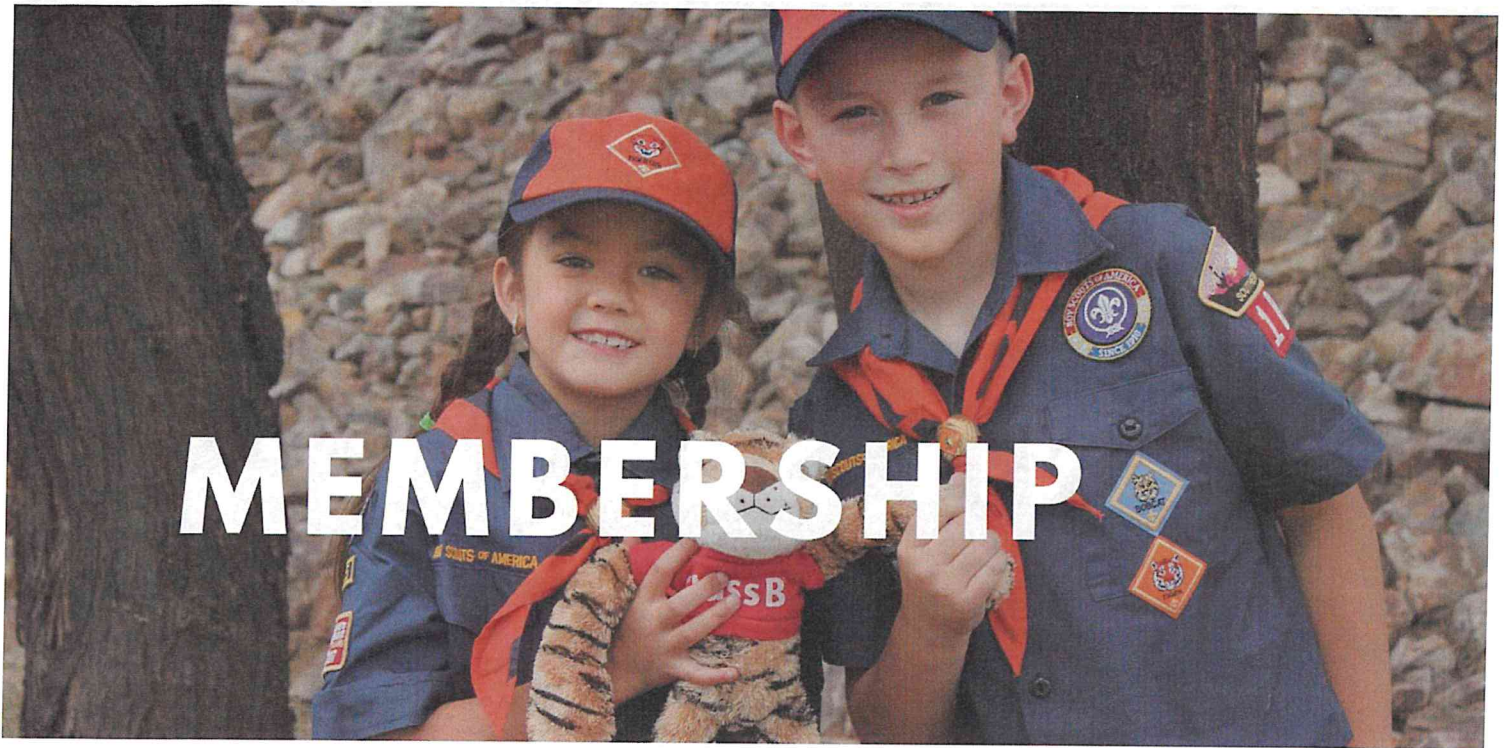
PROGRAM & COMMUNITY IMPACT

- Celebrated the 100th anniversary of Camp Lawton with a special brunch and the publication of a Camp Lawton history by the Tucson Western Corral
- 96 Scouts BSA members earned the Eagle rank
- 1,048 Cubs & Scouts advanced a rank
- 4,130 merit badges were earned by Scouts BSA members
- Our percentage of Direct Contact Leaders trained improved by twelve percent to 58.1%
- Offered a first ever Summer Adventure weekend program for Cubs & Scouts at Camp Lawton
- Recorded 5,587 nights of camping and logged 7,095 miles of hiking
- Over 23,000 service project hours were contributed to our communities in Pima, Cochise, Santa Cruz & Pinal counties



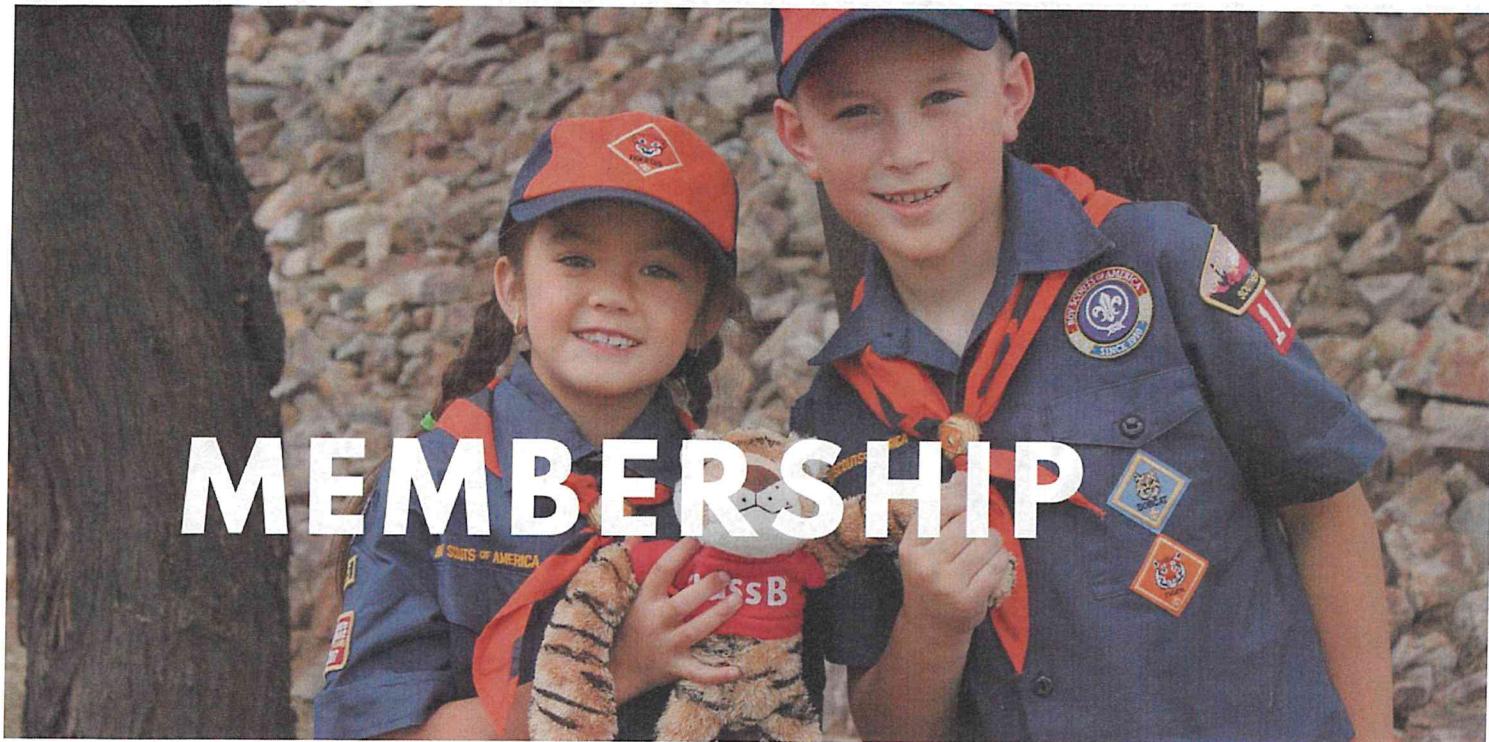
DEVELOPMENT & FINANCE

- Held virtual Eagle Scout Recognition and Good Scout award events
- Relunched a successful Campfire & Candlelight Gala at the Omni Tucson National in November
- Secured a second PPP loan that converted to a grant to help us balance our operating budget
- Increased our cash liquidity and reduced our debt ratios
- Reduced our negative net assets by \$137k (-\$245,600) to (-\$117,500)

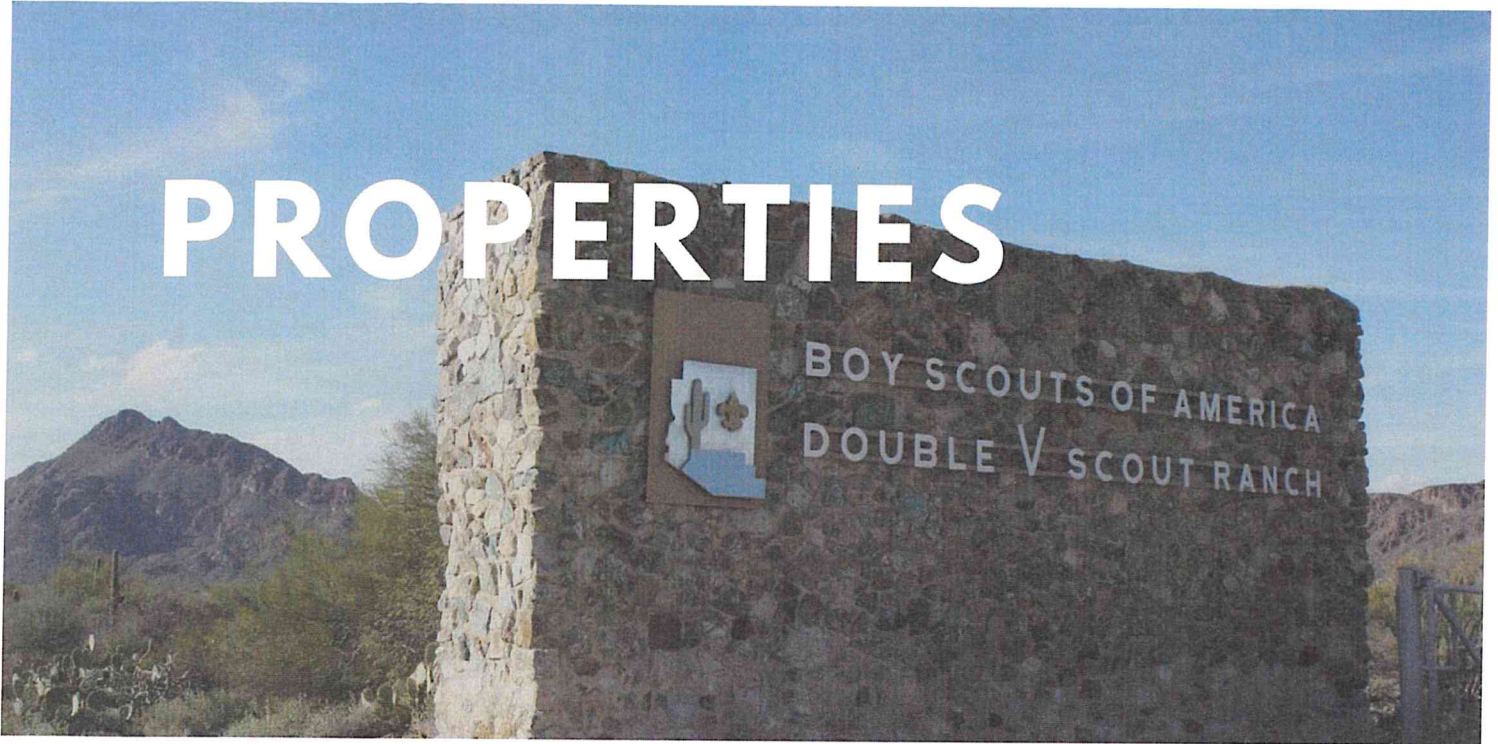


MEMBERSHIP
