Three Tucsonans receive Catalina Council, BSA's highest honors at Good Scout Awards Luncheon

TUCSON, ARIZ (May 9, 2023) – The Catalina Council, BSA, honored three Tucsonans at their annual Good Scout Awards luncheon. This year's honorees are Fred Knapp, Vice President, Core Construction; Barbie Reuter, CEO, Chairman and Designated Broker of Cushman & Wakefield PICOR; and, Christie Lee, CEO & President of TMM Family

Services. The luncheon, held at the Tucson Convention Center, was attended by over 170 business, civic and volunteer leadership, raising more than \$37,000 in support of the Council's youth outreach activities.

"This year's three outstanding business and civic leaders represent the best in Scouting leadership and community service across Southern Arizona," said Jeff Hotchkiss, Catalina Council Scout Executive & CEO. "Our honorees understand that Scouting is about building character, service and community and they embrace the Scout Law's values."

The Good Scout Awards were started in 1982 and are presented to those who exemplify in their daily life the ideals of Scouting as expressed in the Scout Oath and Law. Recipients are chosen for their outstanding community service, as evidenced by their leadership to many worthwhile organizations, as well as the respect and esteem in which they are held by their colleagues.

Knapp is the recipient of the Scouts Lifetime Achievement Award. Knapp's early years of Scouting set the foundation for his work in construction. Knapp began working for his father and has been involved in the construction industry for nearly 45 years, providing business development, directing projects and serving as a liaison between owners, staff and subcontractors.

The Good Scout Award honors Reuter, recognizing her exemplary role in the Southern Arizona business community and reflecting Scouting values through her service and work. Reuter has been with Cushman & Wakefield | PICOR since 1985 and is the firm's current CEO, Board Chair and Designated Broker.

The Distinguished Citizen Award honors Lee's leadership providing outstanding civic service to adults and/or youth in the community. Lee is the President & CEO of TMM Family Services. Before joining TMM Family Services, Lee served as the Member Services Director for the Tucson Metro Director. The nonprofit serves Southern Arizona, working to provide affordable housing in a comprehensive manner, and supportive services to at-risk children, working families, seniors and vets with safe, affordable and quality housing.
