Troop 115 has been active during the pandemic doing safe service projects, including a recent service day at Ft. Lowell park with the Friends of Fort Lowell park.

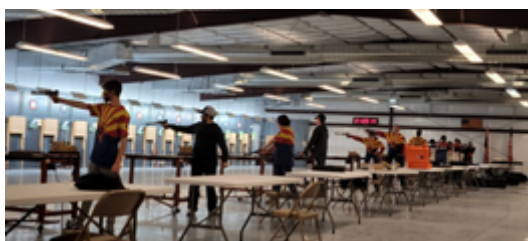
